Parent Recommendations for Counter

- Bright Blue Group
 - Comfortable with all forms of Distraction
 - No control techniques
- Orange Group
 - All forms of Distraction
 - No control techniques
- Light Blue
 - Distraction-creating chaos and zigzag strategy
 - No control techniques
- Pink
 - Distraction-Shout, scream, run zig-zag, throw things
 - No control techniques
- Yellow
 - Distraction-Run and zig zag (get out!!!)
 - No control
- Aqua
 - Distraction-shout, scream, throw items, zig zag running

Comments

- Make sure use of wolf and intruder vocabulary are interchangeable when using the book
- Like the when-then problem solving skills
- Stress any way to get out is okay
- Communicate with and encourage one another aloud (all)
- Need training
- Make sure they know where the rally point is
- Make the drill into some kind of “competition” to create urgency
- We need common language
- Conduct When-Then drills weekly including recess, indoor recess, teacher stepped out scenarios
- Focus on causing chaos

- What tools can be put in the classrooms for distraction (air horn, mace, etc)?
- What to do if you are not with your class?
- What if the teacher is incapacitated?
- What if there is more than one intruder?

 - Distraction-Shout, scream, run zig-zag, throw things
 - Control-Swarm
- Yellow
 - No sheet turned in
- Aqua
 - Distraction-All
 - Control-Charging, kicking, swarming (1 says yes, 2 say no)

Comments

- Communicate with and encourage one another aloud (all)
- Have another form of communication besides the overhead PA

 - Control-charging, kicking, swarming, control limbs, attempt to incapacitate

 - Distraction-All
 - Control-All
- Pink
 - Distraction-Throw items
 - Control-Charge intruder, control limbs, attempt to incapacitate, Isolate weapon
- Yellow
 - Distraction-All
 - Counter-All
- Aqua
 - Distraction-All
 - Control-Charging, kicking, swarming (1 says yes, 2 say no)
