PLEASE READ CAREFULLY: INSTRUCTION ON RULES

This contest is open to all students in grades Pre K through 8
The following grades will fall into four divisions:

Division 1 - Grades Pre K to 2

Division 2 - Grades 3-4

Division 3 - Grades 5-6

Division 4 - Grades 7-8

Division 5—Group—Any combination of grades (no more than 5 per group)

Be creative!!! Any media type is acceptable (poster, song, video, etc.) but the content must be original and may be on any topic related to the ALICE concepts at school. The District would love to include some of these to help train students in the future.

Only one entry per student or group of students (no more than 5 per group) will be accepted.

Each student will be provided with one official entry form.

The following information must be on or attached to the entry.

- a. Individual or Group
- b. Name of student(s)
- c. Name of school (s)
- d. Classroom teacher
- e. Grade of student
- f. Description of the project-(poster, painting, video, song, poem, etc)

All projects must contain full information, be school appropriate and be submitted by the deadline.

GENERAL INFORMATION/TIMELINE:

The contest will be introduced to the students during the week of January 30– February 3, 2017

Turn in your completed entry to your school's office. Completed entries must be submitted to the District Safety Committee through your school office before 4:00 pm March 3, 2017.

A winning entry will be chosen from each division at each school.

Entries will be judged by the District Safety Committee and will be judged based on clarity of message and neatness of the work for your age level. Judging will take place on March 22, 2017.

Winners will be selected and announced before Spring Break and winners will be acknowledged at the School Board Meeting on April 24, 2017.

Winning projects will be shared with the School Board and have a potential to be used in future years as training tools.

Prizes will be awarded in April/May (depending on what is chosen from the prize menu).



General Guidelines

Videos

No more than 3 minutes in length
Must be saved to a thumb drive and be in a program viewable on our computers

Song

Recorded or Videotaped performance

Slide Show (Google Slides or Powerpoint)
Ten Slide maximum

Art Work

Any type of artwork
Poster
Painting, etc.

All entries must be school appropriate or they may be disqualified by judging committee (District Safety Committee). They should focus on aspects of ALICE training with the intent of informing, teaching, or reinforcing the concepts for others.
